The company's one giant leap for mankind is a \$40,000 model dubbed the AquaFit 19DT, an indoor or outdoor "swim spa" that is both a resistance pool and a low-impact, circuit-training gym. You can row, run in place, perform biceps curls and even Pilates. Best of all, this 19-foot-long aquatic fitness center, which is also ideal as a relaxing whirlpool for socializing (you can invite up to a dozen friends to join you), only costs \$35 a month to power. And unlike you, it is super-low maintenance: just change the filter cartridge once every six months.
